Here	<p><b>The History of High Springs 2</b>      <b>N 29° 50.949 W 082° 35.579 - small (1/1.5)</b></p> <p>This facility is private property, feel free to visit, but the property owner asks that you stop in at the office before roaming the grounds. Security is very tight during the summer, therefore no unregistered guests are allowed during these times. YOU DO NOT NEED TO ENTER THE FACILITY TO ACCESS THIS CACHE.</p>
0.5 E	<p><b>Welcome to High Springs</b>      <b>N 29° 50.828 W 082° 35.111 – micro ((1/1)</b></p> <p>Easy park and grab. Welcome to High Springs!</p>
0.9 S	<p><b>Hero 1</b>      <b>N 29° 50.183 W 082° 35.693 – micro (2.5/1)</b></p> <p>A micro in between a BMX track and a cemetery in High Springs.</p> <p>Suemac is one of my heroes. Our most memorable finds have been her caches. They are innovative, challenging, and give you that feeling of just plain WOW! When you find them. Best of all, they are usually in plain sight. This cache is hidden by the High Springs BMX track that the City Council was cool enough to build and maintain.</p>
0.9 W	<p><b>Kulaqua TB Hotel and Gift Shop</b>      <b>N 29° 50.957 W 082° 36.481 – regular (2/1)</b></p> <p>***PLEASE NOTE*** THIS IS A TRAVEL BUG HOTEL..... IN ORDER FOR IT TO STAY IN BUISNESS, IT MUST HAVE GUESTS CHECKED IN, THEREFORE PLEASE DO NOT TAKE A TRAVEL BUG UNLESS YOU CHECK IN ANOTHER TB. *****THANKS*****</p> <p>This cache is located near one of High Springs landmark businesses. Like the adjacent business, it boasts plenty of "cabin" space for visiting TB's and also features a Gift shop full of goodies for the minicachers. Muggles could be a problem as this cache is aside a busy US highway. If you're passing through the business, stop by the waterpark and say HI to the many geocachers inside!! This location is used as a school bus stop, so please replace the cache carefully!!!</p> <p><b>Hint</b> – Vg'f qel haqre urer!!!</p>
1 mile S	<p><b>Hero 2</b>      <b>N 29° 50.066 W 082° 35.834 – micro (4/1)</b></p> <p>An urban micro located in a busy park, located in High Springs.</p> <p><b>Hint</b> – Sbyybj zr</p>
1.5 mile S	<p><b>Hero 3</b>      <b>N 29° 49.691 W 082° 35.883 – micro (3/1)</b></p> <p>You're seeking an urban micro behind the High Springs City Hall. GPS may play tricks on you. And you might want to bring tweezers.</p> <p><b>Hint</b> – Bar bs znal</p>
1.5 mile S	<p><b>The History Of High Springs 1</b>      <b>N 29° 49.711 W 082° 35.983 – micro (1/1)</b></p> <p>The city of High Springs is full of history, in fact, part of downtown has been placed on the National Register of Historic Districts. This is the first in a series to take you on a tour of some of the Historic places in High Springs and also teach you about some of the lesser known historic facts of the city as well.</p> <p>Cacher is in search of a magnetic container hidden on the church property. Services are held here on Saturday mornings, therefore muggles will be a problem at that time, but all are invited inside during these times!!!</p>
1.6 miles S	<p><b>High Springs Depot</b>      <b>N 29° 49.534 W 082° 35.797 – micro (2/1)</b></p> <p>Well-camouflaged micro in downtown High Springs.</p>

2.2 miles SE	<p><b>Pine Hills Cache</b> <span style="float: right;"><b>N 29° 49.264 W 082° 34.571 – regular (1.5/1.5)</b></span></p> <p>You are seeking a clear plastic cylinder, about 3" in diameter x 12" long. This is a site of historical and emotional significance to the black community of High Springs. The gate is not locked, and you are welcome inside, but you don't need to enter to find this cache. Bonus High Springs history: the building next door used to be an oldies radio station.</p> <p><b>Hint</b> - Fgvpxf naq fgbarf</p>
2.3 miles W	<p><b>Oakey Dokey 2</b> <span style="float: right;"><b>N 29° 50.651 W 082° 37.876 - micro (1/1)</b></span></p> <p>This is a micro hidden in a fairly easy location. Parking is not a problem. Visiting this location will allow you to sit back, relax and enjoy God's creation. Before you know it . . . it's all Okey Dokey.</p> <p><b>Hint</b> - Va gur gvgyr</p>
2.4 miles N	<p><b>river rise</b> <span style="float: right;"><b>N 29° 52.954 W 082° 34.926 - regular (2.5/3.5)</b></span></p> <p>This is the second cache i have in Oleno State Park. It is in another part of the park and is alittle over 7 miles round trip from the camp. It was done with mountain bikes while we were camping with family. It has some sandy parts, some smooth areas and some bad areas root wise on trail. If someone was smart they could find the easier way to the cache.</p> <p><b>Hint</b> - evire evfr</p>
2.7 miles E	<p><b>The Forgotten</b> <span style="float: right;"><b>N 29° 51.302 W 082° 32.901 – small (3.5/3.5)</b></span></p> <p>You will be solving a small puzzle to ensure not all are forgotten. Then you will be searching for a well hidden container.</p> <p>This cache is in honor of those that have been forgotten in a little out of the way cemetery. To solve the puzzle, you must find the headstone of Abraham Pino. AB = About how old he was when he died. CDEF = about what year he was born. Once you have these resolve the final coordinates using the following:</p> <p>Lat = 29 B1.2A8 Lon = 082 32.9CD (you don't need E or F)</p> <p>These coordinates will take you to the final cache location. There you are seeking a small Tupperware container with a few trade items that are especially fun for kids (if you have nothing to trade and kids are with you take something anyway). The terrain is a bit of challenge and rock traversing skills will be helpful (better bring a kid).</p> <p>!! Do not cross over the boulders to the other side or climb to the top of them as it is unnecessary and they serve as a barrier to a private quarry!!</p> <p><b>Hint</b> - Bapr lbh ner va gur evtug fcbg gur pbagnvare vf rnfl gb frr.</p>
2.8 miles SE	<p><b>Hero 4 -</b> <span style="float: right;"><b>N 29° 48.818 W 082° 34.132 - micro (1/1)</b></span></p> <p>A micro located in a city sports park just East of High Springs.</p>
3.3 miles NE	<p><b>Haunted Gas Station -</b> <span style="float: right;"><b>N 29° 52.350 W 082° 32.691 – regular (1.5/1.5)</b></span></p> <p>You are seeking a large, cammo'd Rubbermaid container just off the highway.</p> <p>This is a recycled cache container featuring Florida Surveyor's fancy cammo. You do not have to enter the fenced area to find this cache. Should be a quick park and grab for those traveling I-75.</p> <p><b>Hint</b> - Guvf pnpur vf arneyl uvfgbevfp.</p>

3.6 miles NE	<p><b>Traxler</b> <span style="float: right;"><b>N 29° 52.167 W 082° 32.296 – regular (2/1.5)</b></span></p> <p>In the 1880s, William H. Traxler established a general store here and began farming near this section of the historic Old Bellamy Road. In 1891, William Traxler was appointed postmaster to the newly established post office. However, the post office close in 1906. You are seeking a well cammo'ed Tupperware container.</p> <p><b>Hint – Prqne</b></p>
3.7 miles N	<p><b>Old Bellamy Road</b> <span style="float: right;"><b>N 29° 54.174 W 082° 35.114 – regular (1.5/1)</b></span></p> <p>You are seeking a cammo-taped tupperware style container.</p> <p>You can access this site off Hwy. 441, but not from Hwy. 236. Bellamy Road was the main transportation route when north central Florida was being settled. It's also the name of a locally-bred horse favored to win the 2005 Kentucky Derby!</p> <p>The parking area is open from 8:30 a.m. until sunset, but it's easy to walk in if you arrive after dark.</p> <p><b>Hint - Vg'f pnyprerbhf!</b></p>
4.2 miles NE	<p><b>The Road to Damascus</b> <span style="float: right;"><b>N 29° 52.822 W 082° 32.005 – regular (2/2.5)</b></span></p> <p>A good travel bug hide-out within an easy walk but in the summer ground cover could be bothersome. Please be sure to replace as found.</p> <p>This cache is intended to be a travel bug exchange that provides a nice hide yet is very accessible from interstate I75 with no muggle traffic other than cars that may pass by. It has been initially loaded with several Travel Bugs.</p> <p>I have placed this cache just inside of private property. I spoke with the property owner and have obtained permission to have the cache located there. His dogs may visit you should they hear you but they are quite friendly and will not bother you in any way.</p> <p>If you find yourself on the wrong side of the fence, do not scale it but rather walk back around in order to keep the fence from becoming damaged.</p> <p><b>Hint - Fgneg ng gur gbc naq jbx lbhe jnl qbja va beqre gb trg gb gur ebbg bs vg.</b></p>
4.8 miles N	<p><b>Old Leno Town Geocache</b> <span style="float: right;"><b>N 29° 55.147 W 082° 35.390 – regular (1/2)</b></span></p> <p>This cache is in the Oleno State Park. It is about 8 miles south of I-75 on 441. And about the same north of High Springs on 441. This has two micros and a main cache. One micro has the long. and one has the lat. of the main cache.</p> <p>For the get together it will have a log book and tickets for the door prizes. After the event it will have the usual trade items in it. There will be no bushwhacking between or to the micros or main cache. This was emphasized by the Park Mgmt. All the parts are behind logs and are not hard to find just out of sight. The Micros consist of white containers larger than altoids containers and the main cache is a 50cal ammo box. All are less then 10 ft off the trail. Here is the coords for the micros:</p> <p>Parking  29* 55.147N 082* 35.390W  1st Micro is:  29* 55.030N  082* 35.196W behind large rock on bank  2nd Micro is:  29* 55.303N  082* 35.424W  The Long. to the main cache is in one micro and the Lat. is in the other.</p>

	<p>Oleno State Park has a unique history and a geological oddity that many parks can't say they have. The park was acquired in the early 1930s, was developed by the CCC and the Works Progress Authority (WPA) primarily for use as a summer forestry camp and training facility. There is a museum that is open at certain times that tells the whole story of the building of the buildings and the suspension bridge. (that is a must go over) There was a town of Leno on the property that is a ghost town since the railroad bypassed it and it was gone at the turn of the century.</p> <p>Altree and Atwitsend</p> <p><b>Hint</b> - Gur znva pnpur vf bss bs Cnenaref Oenapu Genvy naq bar Zvpeb vf bss gur Yvzrfgbar genvy naq gur bgure vf bss gur Qbtjbbq genvy.</p>
5 miles NE	<p><b>Between Cows and Horses N 29° 53.541 W 082° 31.590 - small ( 2/2)</b></p> <p>A decon container on the side of a single lane dirt road. Muggle traffic is low, but if a car is coming stealth is in order to avoid being questioned as to your purpose in life.</p> <p>This is a small cache with a log only, so bring your own pen. It has initially been loaded with a geocoin and this is a nice cache for exchanging coins.</p> <p><b>Hint</b> - Nal uvag jbhyc fcbvy gur uhag fb lbh ner ba lbhe bja.</p>
